

## CCCS HOMESCHOOL EXTENSION PROGRAM

CCCS offers homeschooling families an educational program that is a convenient and affordable extension of our classroom program. It offers homeschooling families the ability to teach their own children in the convenience of their own home, but with a network of support and services.

CCCS provides all curriculum and lesson plans; the parents will only have to organize and work through the material with their children. Some course work will be able to be done independently by the student, while other subjects may need some instruction or interaction by the parents. Answer keys will be provided, as well as grading sheets to chart progress in each subject. A copy of the grades should be submitted quarterly to CCCS for student records. Additional testing for the high-school level students may be done during their weekly attendance at CCCS.

Once a week, the student will attend class for a day of social interaction, discussion, projects, and experiments. This keeps them connected with other students in their grade both socially and academically. The schedule for in-class attendance is as follows:

Monday—K-1<sup>st</sup> grade  
Tuesday—2<sup>nd</sup> -4<sup>th</sup> grade  
Wednesday—5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade  
Thursday—9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade

The subjects included for grades 1-8 are: math, reading comprehension, literature, vocabulary, language arts, composition, spelling, handwriting, logic, Bible, geography, history, map skills, science, art, P.E. and music.

The subjects included for grades 9-12 are: math, English and literature, Bible, logic, geography, history, science, and art. Music and P.E. will be credits that will need to be extra-curricular activities such as lessons and sports that will be approved and added to the transcript.

The curriculum series that are used include: ABeka, Saxon, Bob Jones, Christian Liberty Press, Answers in Genesis, and Apologia. Literature selections will be classics by well-known authors.

The total cost for the homeschool extension program is \$1400 per student. This includes all materials, answer keys, lesson plans, and one day each week attending CCCS.
